San Joaquin RTD's Presidents Day Holiday Service

(Stockton, CA) – In recognition of the Presidents Day holiday, the San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) Administrative Offices and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) Customer Service Center will be closed on Monday, February 16, 2009.

The following RTD routes will operate on their **Sunday/Holiday** schedules:

- Stockton Metropolitan Area (Metro) Routes 40, 51, 54, 55, 61, 63, 64, 65, 66, 71, 73, 76, 77, 80, 81, 83, 610

The following will operate with **limited** service:

- Countywide General Public Dial-A-Ride (GP DAR)

The following will **NOT** operate:

- Metro Routes 8, 14, 19, 52, 53, 60, 62, 70, 74, 75, 82, 320, 330, 340, 350, 360, 370, 380, 390 and 910, 920, 930, 940, 950
- "Hopper" Routes 90, 91, 93, 94, and 95
- Route 96 (Escalon/Modesto)
- Escalon Dial-A-Ride
- Route 22 Intercity Express

The following will operate on their regular **weekday** schedules:

- Intercity Route 23, **HOWEVER**, service will end with arrivals at Lodi Transportation Station at 7:16 p.m. and at the DTC at 7:14 p.m.
- Intercity Route 24
- Intercity Route 26, **HOWEVER**, service will end with arrivals at the DTC at 7:25 p.m. (from Tracy), and at East/10th Street (Tracy) at 6:28 p.m. (from the DTC)
- Intercity Route 27, **HOWEVER**, service will end with arrivals at the DTC at 7:09 p.m. (from Manteca) and at Main/Mission Ridge (Manteca) at 6:04 p.m. (from the DTC)

RTD will reopen its administrative offices and the DTC Customer Service Center and resume regular service on Tuesday, February 17, 2009.
