San Joaquin RTD's Presidents' Day Holiday Service

(Stockton, CA) – In recognition of the Presidents' Day holiday, the San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) Administrative Offices and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) Customer Service Center will be closed on Monday, February 15, 2010.

The following RTD routes will operate on their **Sunday/Holiday** schedules:

- Stockton Metropolitan Area (Metro) Routes 40, 51, 54, 55, 61, 63, 64, 65, 66, 71, 73, 76, 77, 80, 81, 83, 610

The following will operate with **limited** service:

- Countywide Rural General Public Dial-A-Ride (GP DAR)
- Required ADA Dial-A-Ride

The following will **NOT** operate:

- Metro Routes 19, 52, 53, 60, 74, 75, 310, 320, 330, 340, 345, 350, 360, 370, 380, 390
- Metro Hopper Routes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7
- County Hopper Routes 90, 91, and 93
- Commuter Services Routes 120, 121, and 122

The following will operate on their regular **weekday** schedules:

- Intercity Route 23, **HOWEVER**, service will end with arrivals at the DTC at 6:09 p.m. and at the Lodi Transportation Station at 7:16 p.m. and
- Intercity Route 26, **HOWEVER**, service will end with arrivals at East/10th Street (Tracy) at 6:28 p.m., and the DTC at 7:25 p.m. (from Tracy)
- Intercity Route 27, **HOWEVER**, service will end with arrivals at Main/Mission Ridge (Manteca) at 6:04 p.m. (from the DTC) and at the DTC at 7:09 p.m. (from Manteca)

RTD will reopen its administrative offices and the DTC Customer Service Center and resume regular service on Tuesday, February 16, 2010.
