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RTD Discontinues Service on Easter Sunday

(Stockton, CA) – On Easter Sunday, April 4, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will not operate its regular fixed route or Dial-A-Ride services. RTD will be operating a limited demand response service by reservation on a first-come, first served basis. The fare for a one-way trip will be \$5.00 per passenger. Priority will be given to passengers who are elderly or with disabilities.

Reservations must be made by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 31. Reservations will be limited to one round-trip per passenger. Reservations for limited demand response service can be made by calling (209) 955-8400.

This action is necessary due to reductions in transit funding, and is similar to RTD's operations on other holidays. RTD's holiday ridership is a fraction of regular service days, but with even higher costs. RTD's goal is to reduce costs while affecting the fewest passengers, thereby retaining funds for heavily used service.

RTD will resume regular service on Monday, April 5.
