San Joaquin RTD's Veterans Day Holiday Service

(Stockton, CA) – In recognition of the Veterans Day holiday, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) administrative offices and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) Customer Service Center will be closed on Thursday, November 11, 2010.

The following RTD routes will operate on their **Sunday/Holiday** schedules:

- Stockton Metropolitan Area (Metro) Routes 40, 51, 54, 55, 68, 71, 73, 76, 80, 81, and 83
- Intercity Routes 23, 26, and 27

The following will operate with **limited** service:

- Metro Hopper Routes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 and ADA Dial-A-Ride service
- Countywide Rural General Public Dial-A-Ride (GP DAR)
- Only one Commuter **route to Sacramento (via Highway 99)** will operate: a combination of Routes 163, 165, and 176

The following will **NOT** operate:

- Metro Routes 19, 52, 53, 60, 61, 63, 64, 65, 66, 74, 75, 310, 325, 330, 340, 345, 350, 360, 370, 380, and 390
- County Hopper Routes 90, 91, 92, and 93

RTD will reopen its administrative offices and the DTC Customer Service Center and resume regular service on Friday, November 12, 2010.
