Metro Express Bus Stop & Shelter Temporarily Relocated

(Stockton, CA) – On September 7, 2007, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) temporarily relocated its northbound Pacific Avenue Metro Express (Route 40) bus stop, shelter, and fare vending machine from the north side of Yokuts Avenue to the south side.

RTD relocated this stop during construction at the future site of the Elephant Bar at the northeast corner of Pacific and Yokuts. The stop will remain in its temporary location during construction. RTD plans to return the stop to the north side of Yokuts when construction concludes (anticipated to be toward the end of October or early November).

RTD customers can continue to use the fare vending machine in the temporary stop location. Customers are advised that the temporary stop location serves both the Metro Express (Route 40) and Intercity Route 23.
