San Joaquin RTD's Independence Day Holiday Service

(Stockton, CA) – In recognition of the Independence Day holiday, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) administrative offices and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) Customer Service Center will be closed on Friday, July 4, 2008.

The following RTD routes will operate on their **Sunday/Holiday** schedules:

- Stockton Metropolitan Area (Metro) Routes 13, 40, 51, 54, 55, 60, 61, 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 71, 73, 76, 77, 80, 81, 610
- Intercity Routes 23 & 26

The following will operate with **limited** service:

- Rural Elderly and Disabled Dial-A-Ride service
- Countywide Rural General Public Dial-A-Ride (GP DAR)

The following will **NOT** operate:

- Metro Routes 8, 9, 18, 19, 52, 53, 70, 74, 75, 82, 320, 330, 340, 360, 370, 380, 390 and 910, 920, 930, 940, 950
- Intercity Route 24
- "Hopper" Routes 90, 91, 93, 94, and 95
- Route 96 (Escalon/Modesto)
- Escalon Dial-A-Ride
- Route 22 Intercity Express

RTD will reopen its administrative offices and the DTC Customer Service Center and resume regular service on Monday, July 7, 2008.
