San Joaquin RTD's Martin Luther King, Jr. Day Holiday Service

(Stockton, CA) – In recognition of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Day holiday, the San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) Administrative Offices and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) Customer Service Center will be closed on Monday, January 21, 2008.

The following RTD routes will operate on their **Sunday/Holiday** schedules:

- Stockton Metropolitan Area (Metro) Routes 13, 40, 51, 54, 55, 60, 61, 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 71, 73, 76, 77, 80, 81, 610

The following will operate with **limited** service:

- Rural Elderly and Disabled Dial-A-Ride service
- Countywide Rural General Public Dial-A-Ride (GP DAR)

The following will **NOT** operate:

- Metro Routes 8, 9, 18, 19, 52, 53, 70, 74, 75, 320, 330, 340, 360, 370, 380, 390 and 910, 920, 930, 940, 950
- "Hopper" Routes 90, 91, 93, 94, and 95
- Route 96 (Escalon/Modesto)
- Escalon Dial-A-Ride
- Route 22 Intercity Express

The following will operate on their regular **weekday** schedules:

- Intercity Route 23, **HOWEVER**, service will end with arrivals at Lodi Transportation Station at 7:07 p.m. and at the DTC at 7:09 p.m.
- Intercity Route 24, **HOWEVER**, service will end with arrival at Hammertown-West Lane (Kaiser Permanente) at 6:32 p.m.
- Intercity Route 26, **HOWEVER**, service will end with arrivals at the DTC at 6:25 p.m. (from Manteca), 6:59 p.m. (from Tracy); and in Ripon, arriving at 6:50 p.m.

RTD will reopen the DTC Customer Service Center and administrative offices and resume regular service on Tuesday, January 22, 2008.
